Dear Mr. Johnson:

Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of West Virginia, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Deputy Tax Commissioner of the West Virginia State Tax Division, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that West Virginia is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of July 1, 2024.

No changes have been made to West Virginia statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect West Virginia's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since July 1, 2023.

As part of this annual recertification, West Virginia updated its Online Certificate of Compliance and Taxability Matrix (Part 1 – Library of Definitions and Part 2 – Tax Administration Practices) which reflect West Virginia's laws enacted through August 1, 2024 and has approved them to be published on the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board website beginning August 1, 2024.
